"An interactive multi-modal learning environment is one in which what happens depends on the actions of the learner." Moreno & Mayer (2007)



Fink's Taxonomy of Significant Learning: Learning is *interactive* and *relational*, not hierarchical.



Learning Objectives Fink Taxonomy of Significant Learning

Integration (3)

What connections (similarities and interactions) should students recognize and make...

- Among ideas within this course?
 - Between the information, ideas, and perspectives in this course and those in other courses or areas?

Application (2)

What kinds of thinking are important for students to learn here: Critical thinking, in which students analyze and evaluate? Creative thinking, in which students imagine and create? Practical thinking, in which students solve problems and make decisions?

Foundational Knowlege (1)

What key information (facts, terms, formula, concepts, relations...) is important for students to understand and remember in the future?









Student blogging requires selection, organization and integration

Student Blog: Post on Interpersonal Communication Conflict




Student-generated Video Production



Producing the video requires


- Conceptualizing (selecting, organizing & integrating)

Becoming more aware of self and others (Fink's Human Dimension)

Managing emotions and responding to potentially difficult situations (Fink's *Caring & Application*)
